For the past three years, BayRICS has received regional funding for public safety broadband planning and governance. This proposal is for \$59,000 for contract services to support terrorism preparedness by continued support for broadband planning activities, and also regional governance activities required to ensure interoperability of public safety voice and broadband data communications. Funding will be used to coordinate the deployment of the FirstNet nationwide public safety broadband network in the Bay Area, and to develop and implement regional governance policies and procedures for public safety voice and data communications
