**Background:**

On January 20, 2012, the Approval Authority approved the FY 2012 UASI grant funding allocation methodology for the allocation of grant funds within the BAUASI. On February 17, 2012, FEMA released the FY 2012 UASI Grant guidelines. The amount allocated to the Bay Area Urban Area was \$26,423,268 and the State must pass through at least 80 percent (80%) of these funds to the UASI. Because the Bay Area UASI received more than the Approval Authority-approved \$14.2 million threshold, the balance of the remaining funds will be allocated to the Planning Hubs using the risk formula below:

The West Bay Hub will be allocated 44% of the remaining amount.  
The South Bay Hub will be allocated 27% of the remaining amount.  
The East Bay will be allocated 22% of the remaining amount.  
The North Bay will be allocated 7% of the remaining amount.

**Discussion/Description:**
